Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The federal government has a plan to dismantle and privatise our Medicare system.

They have off-loaded most of their healthcare responsibilities to the provinces, and abolished their capacity to play a coordinating role through the now defunct Health Council of Canada.

The Harper government has chosen to ignore the creeping privatisation of health care and blocked the creation of new Medicare programs like pharmacare or enforcement of national standards that would ensure all Canadians are treated the same.

Soon we will face an even bigger threat.

The federal-provincial agreement that guarantees public health care funding expires in 2014. It is called the Health Accord. The Conservatives' have said that they plan to decrease federal transfers to provinces by \$36 billion before the end of 2024.

In Nova Scotia, this will mean cuts to our public system of \$902 million over the next 10 years. That will add to the challenges we are facing meeting the demand for medical procedures, maintaining the number of hospital beds in our province, and ensuring that rural areas are properly served! We cannot afford these drastic cuts to health care.

CUPE is responding to this threat by launching a nation-wide campaign that will pressure the Federal government to renegotiate a fair Health Accord. We need to make sure that Nova Scotians have access to the same high quality health care services as those in other Canadian provinces.

Our campaign will be rolling out in three provinces in 2013! <u>In Nova Scotia the two-week</u> campaign starts September 22nd and ends October 5th.

Working with the Council of Canadians, the Nova Scotia Citizens' Health Care Network and other allies, CUPE will be organizing workshops, public outreach campaigns, and mediagrabbing events including the Shout Out for Health Care Town Hall October 3rd from 6pm to 8pm at the Blockhouse Fire Hall, Blockhouse and a Community Festival for Public Medicare October 5th from 2pm to 4pm at Shipyard Landing, Bridgewater .

The Conservatives' privatization by stealth strategy hurts smaller and aging provinces like NS the most. The federal government is not living up to their responsibility to Nova Scotians. We cannot let this continue.

It's time the Feds paid their fair share of the health care bill- at least 25%. The federal government must negotiate a new Health Accord with the premiers that will meet the needs of Nova Scotians, treat everyone in Canada fairly, and provide the care that seniors require to remain healthy and age with dignity.

The Health Accord campaign has at its core a series of workshops for members who want to be a part of the fight to stand up for Medicare. These workshops will communicate to CUPE members and our allies how the Harper government is wreaking health care and allowing privatization to creep into our system.

We are asking CUPE members and our allies to volunteer to participate in our workshops, Town Hall and Community Festival. At the workshops you will take away the following information and skills:

- A better understanding of the federal government's points of weakness. For example, how we can mobilize the provinces to pressure the Feds, and also how we can mobilize the public to call for a universal Pharmacare program.
- Learn about how to lobby elected officials and talk to the public about this issue.

The federal conservatives have been stealthily and relentlessly working to dismantle Canada's public health care system. We need to expose the federal government's actions and draw the public's attention and anger to this issue! All residents of Canada need a new Accord and a new federal government!
